GENERAL INFORMATION

The Northrop Rice Foundation is pleased to administer the American Eurocopter Maintenance Training Scholarship. American Eurocopter is donating one scholarship per year for one instructor at an ATEC member school that is a member of the Northrop Rice Foundation, or an individual member of the Foundation. The scholarship provides for attendance in any one of the two-week Airframe Field Maintenance Courses on how to maintain Eurocopter helicopters. This training scholarship will be awarded to an instructor selected by the Board of the Northrop Rice Foundation.

The training course will be conducted at the facility of American Eurocopter, 2701 Forum Drive North, Grand Prairie, TX. The courses available are listed on the American Eurocopter web site. The value of the scholarship is \$4165.00

In order to be considered for selection for this scholarship the applicant must meet the following conditions and requirements.

Scholarship Conditions and Requirements

1. The deadline for submission of applications is January 31.
2. The applicant must possess one of the following:
 - a. Certificate as an A&P technician.
 - b. Canadian approved Aircraft Maintenance Engineering Certificate.
 - c. One year of experience as an active mechanic on helicopters (Commercial or Military).
 - d. Three years of general experience as a commercial or military aircraft mechanic.
 - e. The applicant must be an employee of a school that is a member of the Northrop Rice Foundation, or an individual member of the Foundation
3. Only one instructor from any school will be considered each academic year.
4. All applicants must submit a letter of recommendation from a person who is an aviation professional and is not associated with the school at which the instructor is employed.
