GENERAL INFORMATION

The Northrop Rice Foundation is pleased to administer the FlightSafety International King Air Maintenance Course Scholarship. FSI is donating one scholarship per year for one instructor at a PART 147 School that is a member of the Northrop Rice Foundation. The scholarship provides for attendance in one of FSI's King Air Maintenance Courses. The scholarship is valued at \$7,200.00 and will be awarded to an instructor selected by the Board of the Northrop Rice Foundation.

The King Air Maintenance Course is of two week duration and is conducted at the FSI facilities in Wichita, KS. In order to be considered for selection for the FSI Scholarship Award the applicant must meet the following requirements.

Scholarship Conditions and Requirements

1. Deadline date for submission of applications is January 31. The name of the recipient will be announced at the ATEC Annual Conference.
2. The instructor must be teaching at a PART 147 school that is a member of the Northrop Rice Foundation and have approval of the school administrator.
3. Only one instructor from any school will be considered unless in the opinion of the Selection Committee there are extenuating circumstances.
4. All applicants are required to submit letters of recommendation from two professional persons who are not associated with the school at which the instructor is employed.
5. A description of how past work and accomplishments have resulted in the enhancement of Aviation Maintenance student education.
6. List of subjects taught.

The scholarship winner will be announced at the Annual Conference of the Aviation Technician Education Council in Phoenix, AZ April 14-17, 2012. If the applicant is not notified by April 30 he/she can assume that he/she has not been successful in this award endeavor.
