

NORTHROP RICE FOUNDATION JAMES VILLNAVE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Northrop Rice Foundation is pleased to administer the James Villnave Memorial Scholarship sponsored by the James Villnave Charitable Trust. Application for these scholarships may be made by students and instructors of FAA Approved PART 147 and honorably discharged veterans who are preparing to take the Federal Aviation Administration written examinations for certification as Aviation Maintenance Technicians (A&P).

Mr. Villnave was a well-known aviation maintenance figure in the Kansas City area and he was the owner of the Villnave Airport in Belton, MO. The scholarships may be applied toward tuition, upgrade training expenses, books, or tools depending on the category of assistance requested.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS

PART 147 SCHOOL STUDENTS

PART 147 Aviation Maintenance Training School students must file a JVMS Student Application and provide the information and documentation requested on the application. These funds are to be used for tuition assistance and are in the maximum amount of \$1,000.00 per year. Deadline for submitting applications is March 1.

PART 147 SCHOOL INSTRUCTORS

PART 147 Aviation Maintenance Training School instructors must file a JVMS Instructor Application and provide the information and documentation requested on the JVMS Instructor Application. These funds are to be used to cover the travel and per diem expenses for instructors attending short-term upgrading training. Documented expenses up to \$1,000.00 are covered by this scholarship. Deadline for submitting applications is March 1.

VETERANS OF US MILITARY FORCES AVIATION BRANCHES

This scholarship is intended to assist honorably discharged veterans with military aviation maintenance experience who are planning to apply for the Federal Aviation Administration certification as Aviation Maintenance Technicians (A&P). This scholarship is available to veterans who qualify to sit for the FAA Airframe and/or Powerplant written examinations. This scholarship will cover the cost of reference text books, study guides, Federal Air Regulations, and mechanic's handbook for either or both written examinations. Applications for this scholarship will be accepted on a continuing basis.
